Purpose of the Working Group

The charge to the working group is to establish a single schema that meets the requirements articulated by CDWA-Lite and Museumdat and subsequent reviews. The working group should deliver:

- a single schema
- a new complementary version of the OAI-Cat server software
- a new complementary version of the application initially developed by Ted Dancescu to write data to a schema compliant XML document

The schema should:

1. be based on the CDWA-Lite schema
2. take into account the modifications proposed in Museumdat
3. take into account the addition of "Object Credit"
4. provide a mechanism to capture set information (being clear on the purposes of sets)
5. consider and make a recommendation on the proposal for a smaller number of required data elements
6. consider and make recommendations on additional suggestions made by Martin Doerr
7. look forward to and describe compatibility and use with OAI-ORE
